

Decorating Committee Update: Blue Room

Dear Neighbours

You will notice a display board set up on the south side of the lobby. This is a collage of photos of the fabrics chosen for the Blue Room and the paint colours. All colours are Benjamin Moore Paints. We have consulted with three different interior decorators and have carefully selected the colours to complement the colours that we previously selected for the upholstery

- Palladian Blue is for the upper walls, currently wallpapered.
- Featherdown is for the lower wall (currently deep blue) and the baseboards and chair rail
- Featherdown Half Tint (50% lighter) with a slight sheen is the for mantel and the bar. These areas will be professionally refinished not just painted with a brush and roller.

The Palladian Blue will continue on the back wall of the kitchen including the doors to the cooking area in order to blend the area into the main colour scheme.

It should be noted that the solid blue fabric in the photos which will cover the two love seats does not photograph as its true colour. It comes out blue/grey no matter what we do with lighting. It's true colour is a greenish/blue – hence the choice of Palladian Blue for the walls. In person it is the best choice of paint as recommended by our designer.

The upper mouldings and ceiling will remain white – Cloud White has been chosen as it is a little warmer than stark white ceiling paint.

We were pleased to hear this week that our upholstered furniture from Flexsteel should arrive in 4-6 weeks. Considerably earlier than originally predicted. We have yet to hear an arrival date for the Canadel dining furniture.

- Two loveseats in solid blue
- Two compact wing chairs (smaller than the one depicted) in the print
- Two dining chairs with arms in green as in the picture
- Four dining chairs no arms in the same green
- Two cream chairs (which actually are also dining chairs if required) for the bay window.

We are considering a sideboard – depicted in green but more likely, if chosen, to be in the same woodtone as the dining table.

The decorating committee has decided to add small tables, lamps and other accessories after the major pieces of furniture are in place so as to keep scale and function a priority,

It is hoped to add a deeper quartz countertop to the bar to provide extra serving space.
